ACCESS YOUR ACCOUNT AT VOYA!

Your Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston 401(k) Retirement Savings Plan (the Plan) is now live with Voya! During the transition period, the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston partnered with Voya[®] to ensure that all account balances, contributions, investments, and beneficiaries were transferred seamlessly from TIAA to Voya. *Note: you will continue to have access to your historical Plan information on the TIAA website (tiaa.org) for one year.*

REGISTER YOUR ACCOUNT

Visit **rcab.voya.com** to register your account and learn more about the Plan, including new participant tools and resources available at Voya.

- Go to **rcab.voya.com** and select Register Now. It is important to register your account so that you will be eligible to be covered by Voya's S.A.F.E.[®] Guarantee.
- Enter your security information:
- Personal Identification Number (PIN) which was mailed to your address on file, and Social Security number (SSN)
- Or SSN and date of birth
- Create a secure Username and Password to access your account via the website or **Voya Retire**[®] mobile app.
- Provide an email address and your mobile phone number for future recovery of your Username and Password.

Note: You will always need your PIN to make automated transactions or to speak to a Voya customer service associate. If you do not have your PIN, visit **rcab.voya.com** or call **855-817-1664** to request a new one.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE, ONCE YOU HAVE REGISTERED YOUR ACCOUNT AT VOYA

- 1 Review your account information and make sure that it is accurate.
- 2 Confirm your email and mobile number are on file for security purposes.
- 3 Review your investment elections and make changes online.

Active eligible employees and priests may make payroll contribution changes online.
